JAPAN EARTHQUAKE DONATIONS

AMERICAN SUZUKI MOTOR CORPORATION INFORMATION as of March 16, 2011

We've received many inquiries asking how to help the Japanese relief efforts following the magnitude-8.9 quake and deadly tsunami. The devastation is widespread and little remains in many communities. The full impact has not yet been determined but your help during this time of need would be greatly appreciated.

Below are some organizations, approved by the Better Business Bureau, that are working on relief and recovery in the region. Go to their websites to research the organization, its activities in the relief effort and to make a voluntary donation.

American Red Cross: Given the widespread damage and enormous humanitarian needs, the Japanese Red Cross is accepting financial support from the American Red Cross. At least 370,000 people have been evacuated or displaced and 2,000 shelters are being supported by the Japanese Red Cross. www.redcross.org

GlobalGiving: Working with other organizations on the ground to provide immediate relief to victims of the earthquake and tsunami. www.globalgiving.org

Save the Children: Has sent an emergency response team to assess the needs of children and their families in the vast area affected by the tsunami. www.savethechildren.org

Salvation Army: The Salvation Army is an international organization and has been in Japan since 1895. There are currently 3 emergency service teams in the areas affected by the earthquake and tsunami. One is assisting people evacuated from areas threatened by the damage to the nuclear power plants. www.salvationarmyusa.org

Americares: Focused on evaluating damage to medical facilities and determining urgent areas of emergency assistance. They are prepared to support hospitals and health responders with supplies they need to diagnose, treat and heal survivors. www.americares.org

International Medical Corps: Has a team on the ground in Japan coordinating with local officials to support the response efforts and fill critical gaps. They are prepping critical supplies for delivery to the earthquake zone. www.Internationalmedicalcorps.org
